

***BRIDGE PROGRAM-A COOPERATIVE PROJECT OF REITZ MEMORIAL HIGH SCHOOL AND THE UNIVERSITY OF EVANSVILLE***

Each semester students are given the opportunity to enroll in the Bridge Program. Students enroll through the University of Evansville with the courses being taught at the high school by high school teachers in cooperation with the university's professors. Course offerings will vary from semester to semester. Bridge courses may be from areas including the natural sciences, social sciences, mathematics, humanities, fine arts, and foreign languages. Students are required to pay a special tuition rate, which is significantly less than the tuition for on-campus courses. Each student receives University of Evansville credit for courses taken, and the student's grades for the courses are recorded on a UE transcript. The University will officially enroll at the beginning of each semester those students who wish to participate.

In addition to the Bridge Program with the University of Evansville, students also have the opportunity to take dual credit courses through Ivy Tech State College.
